## Pierce College Strategic Master Plan

### California Community Colleges Student Success Scorecard

- Student Success Scorecard is the statewide accountability system introduced in April 2013 to replace ARCC
- There are eight (8) measures in two(2) categories:
  - Completion
  - Momentum Points

#### Student Success Scorecard, cont.

- Completion Measures:
  - Completion students earning a degree, certificate, or transferring within six (6) years
  - <u>Career and Technical Education</u> –
     occupational students completing a
     certificate, degree, or transfer within
     six (6) years

#### Scorecard Measures, cont.

- Momentum Points
  - Completion of 30 Units new students completing 30+ units within six (6) years
  - Persistence new students enrolling for at least three (3) consecutive semesters

#### Scorecard Measures, cont.

- Remedial Progress students whose first enrollment is in a course below college-level and who complete a college-level course within six (6) years in the following disciplines:
  - English
  - •ESL
  - Mathematics

#### Scorecard Measures, cont.

- <u>Career Development and College</u> <u>Preparation</u> – students enrolling in certain noncredit courses and earning a noncredit certificate, credit certificate or degree, or transfer within six (6) years
- •The 2014 Scorecard reports outcomes for students who started in 2007-2008 through 2012-2013


## Why is the Scorecard important?

- Accountability and transparency of the CCC system
- Relationship to the Institution Set Standards (ISS) required by the ACCJC beginning January 2013
- Usefulness of the data to set success benchmarks statewide and success goals for individual colleges

#### System-wide Student Success Goals

- July 2014 Board of Governors approved system-wide goals for quantifiable improvement in several key areas
- Completion Goal to increase the completion rate by 2.5 percent each year leading to 227,000 additional degree or certificate awards or transfers over the next decade of cohorts
- Completion rate increases from 48.1 percent to 62.8 percent

#### Freshman Classes Entering 2014 to 2024


